Traffic & Safety Information

We continue to have problems with people speeding in the Woodbridge neighborhoods.

Our posted speed limit is **25 MPH**, not the 40 to 50 MPH we see from some individuals.

We have even had passing reported on Dunes Drive!

This is a neighborhood, with children playing, neighbors out for their morning or evening walk, golfers crossing the road in their carts.

Please slow down, it could be your child, dog or family member that is hurt because of someone's disregard of the speed limit.



Parents did you know that you must be at least 16 years old to operate a golf cart in the state of North Carolina?

If you allow your children to operate the golf cart, you could be held responsible for any damage that they cause!

ATV's are prohibited from being operated on all streets and are absolutely banned from the golf course property.

The NC statute reads:

§ 20-171.19. Prohibited acts by owners and operators. (e) Except as otherwise permitted by law, no person shall operate an all-terrain vehicle on any public street, road, or highway except for purposes of crossing that street, road, or highway.
