FINANCIAL REPPORT:

Invoices for mowing the vacant lots should go out this week.

As of May 1, 2015 our Accounts Receivable was \$2,624.83 which includes late fees and interest. A lot of time, energy, and expense goes into collecting past dues. We have met with our Lawyer, and the board has agreed to start taking action by filing liens, and or, taking delinquent property owners to small claims court.

The association Bylaws and Declaration provide for the collection of monthly amounts to cover, among other things, the use of common areas and property maintenance/repairs. *North Carolina law provides that the association may place a lien against your property for the unpaid dues plus costs and attorney's fees.*Therefore, it is important that you make immediate payment to avoid unnecessary costs and a lien being placed against your property.
