

**Temporary Camper Trailer Storage Requirements**  
**Woodbridge Homeowners Association**  
**2026**

**Summary:**

This document provides the Environmental Control Committee compliance requirements for exception to request Temporary Camper Trailer Storage at Woodbridge.

**Reference:**

Woodbridge Bylaws and Restrictions including Boat and Trailer Storage and Covenants.

**Requirement**

- 1-Request for Camper Trailer Storage is received by the Environmental Committee and reviewed as a single exception to the Restrictions on an individual basis.
- 2-Camper Trailer Storage exceptions are valid for one year with renewal on or before the last Friday in June.
- 3-One Camper Trailer Storage per HOA homeowner.
- 4-Camper Trailer Storage is not to be used for accommodations or bulk storage.
- 5-Camper Trailer must be registered to current North Carolina DMV with current tag attached.
- 6-Camper Trailer must meet RV Industry Association and Federal Motor Vehicle Standards.
- 7-Camper Trailer must be maintained to OEM conditions including (not limited to) exterior surfaces, frame and wheels.
- 8-Camper Trailer Storage is not allowed for commercial applications.
- 9-Camper Trailer Storage must be located on a solid, non-permeable surface.
- 10-Camper Trailer Storage must not block or obscure line of sight of adjacent neighbors or impede traffic.
- 11-Camper Trailer Storage utility connection is limited to storage condition requirements.
- 12-Camper Trailer connection waste dump to a septic system is not allowed.
